DIRECTOR'S LETTER

Love Europe? What is there not to love about Europe? The diversity and richness of culture, the varied and breathtaking landscapes, the historic buildings with wide ranging architectural influences, the sumptuous culinary options – yes, I love Europe!

There is however a more fundamental reason why I love Europe and that is because God loves Europe. CONNECTING ACROSS EUROPE

After finding ourselves with some available time, my dad and I knew that we wanted to fill it by going to another European country to help with a project or a ministry. Through ECM, we were introduced to Dan and Primrose, missionaries in Kamenica, Kosovo. After various zoom calls and forms, we went out to join them for three weeks.

We had a wonderful experience learning about the culture and language, especially as Albanian was not something we had any experience of! We were able to help Primrose in her daily work teaching English to teens by reading with them, as well as play games with them at some social events. We hosted a sports event while we were there and I gave my testimony to the young people in the refreshment break. My Dad also helped Dan with his work supporting a group of men in the town who have disabilities and learning difficulties who meet twice weekly to play sport, games and drink coffee.

It was wonderful to get to know the town of Kamenica and some of its people. In a place where engaging with people about Christianity can take a lot of time and personal investment, and where opportunities can be few, it was a privilege to see how the Avilas live for Jesus in that place. We had great laughs and chats around the dinner table, and times of

sharing. We appreciated attending their daily devotions looking at the Psalms, praying together and joining them at church. They also took us on an overnight trip to Peja, on the west side of the country, where they used to live and where other mission teams are based.

After going on short-term mission to Kosovo, seeing another culture, speaking a different language and experiencing another way of life, we have both grown as people spiritually and mentally. We learned so much in a short time: about ourselves and the place, about mission, and most importantly, about the Lord and all His goodness.

Kosovo will definitely have a special place in my heart and I fully intend to head back very soon. I can't recommend short-term mission enough and we are so thankful we had ECM to help with everything and pray for us whilst we were out there. We continue to pray for their work as they share the love of Christ all over Europe.

UNA HISTORIA MEJOR - A BETTER STORY.

In the midst of so much bad news, war, hurt, fleeing, pain, we have a better story to tell. We have a hope that lasts, and we want to share this with Europe; we want to share Jesus.

I work with university students in Barcelona and we have just launched a new evangelistic resource that consists of six seeker bible studies all based on looking at the Better Story that the Bible has to tell in relation to six ruptures in today’s society: climate change, immigration, corruption, internal battles, machismo and truth. Each of the studies point to God’s salvation plan in Jesus, starting with Creation and ending with the resurrected Jesus.

The aim is to see students open this resource with a friend and study what the Bible says about each one of these topics, loving their friends in a practical way as they share the good news that we have in Jesus. Students reaching students with the gospel; this is the vision of GBU (Grupos Bíblicos Universitarios), the Christian Union in Spain, as we want every student in Spain to have the opportunity to hear and respond to the gospel of Jesus.

Personal evangelism, talking about Jesus to your friends and classmates, is just one way that we share the gospel. Another way is through wider mission activities; in

February 2024 we held Events Week in one of the university campuses in Barcelona where we invited students to come along to events on the topic of “Something More” – Algo Más.

It wasn’t straightforward to organise, with the university hindering some of the activities planned and many last-minute changes, however through personal invitations, interacting with students with whiteboard questions and giving out thousands of flyers (and kitkats!), many students came along to the events to hear about Something More. It was a real joy for me to see Christian students who love Jesus engage with people on campus, challenging them as to where they are placing their hope and basing their life, and inviting them to explore more. I feel privileged to work with these students, to see them grow in faith and boldness as they step out of their comfort zone and share Jesus here in Spain.

Coimbra is our beautiful city and known as the city of knowledge. Across the river you can see the lights are on and the university shines bright. Spiritually speaking, Coimbra is heavy in sin; the light of God's Word during the Reformation never reached Portugal and the gospel work is hard. It takes time and there is a lack of resources, gospel workers and affordable Christian literature.

There's beauty and hope if we look at the sun; it is setting, but one thing we're certain is that it will dawn and God's light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it (John 1:5). It's been a real privilege to support the work that GBU (IFES) Coimbra is doing. Last year, Carlos taught two sessions for university evangelistic events. One was about a Coldplay song "Fix you", (as the band was coming to Coimbra), and the other about Halloween.

Ana is the "The Mark Drama" coordinator for Portugal and has been involved in several performances by GBU Coimbra - "The Mark Drama is an innovative way of experiencing the Gospel of Mark and communicating it to others, performed as theatre-in-the-round." It's a great evangelistic tool but it transforms and edifies the ones that take part. Even though GBU isn't doing a performance this year, our church will on the 23rd and 24th of March and amongst the team we have a few university students that will invite their friends and family.

One of the great things we've been witnessing in our church is their openness to university students. Once, the attitude was seeing them attend for a short time (here today and gone tomorrow) and no relationship building took place. Now, older people are inviting students to their homes and sharing their lives. God's Word through God's Spirit has been transforming lives in Coimbra and it's great to be a part of this and witness all that God has been doing.

Another ministry we're involved with is called Proclama (Proclaim). Our aim is to promote the proclamation of the gospel of Jesus through conferences, translation, support Christians considering theological education to go into ministry. In May, we're running a conference which is open to all denominations with Leonardo di Chirico as our main speaker. We hope that all Christians will be reminded and encouraged by the amazing Grace in the gospel of our Lord Jesus, from darkness light!
