Given that evangelical Christians make up about 0.05% of the population (that is 5 in every 10,000), they need help. Bosnia is probably the least Christian country in Europe.


We would like young (or not so young) people who are mature believers and can talk freely about their faith but who also want to see the need to pray and can cope with a program which might not be tightly scripted.
