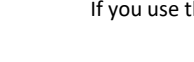
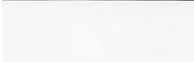
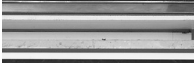
NEW ZEALAND: Geoff and Glenda Hubbard, New Candidates for Spain
