"We so much enjoyed visiting Adi and Jen (and of course Anna and Luca) and gaining a better understanding of their current family and ministry context. As you can imagine, Luca's serious accident just after they returned really took the wind out of their sails, following an encouraging Home Assignment, so these last few months have been harder than they had hoped. Their context is really challenging, yet despite these challenges, Jen and Adi have shown incredible resilience. It takes time to set family up for long term ministry, and our prayer is that many of the challenges will pass or diminish over time. The house, when they are able to move in, will give them much more breathing space and will eventually be a wonderful base for life and ministry. Anna and Luca will, we pray, in time, become more comfortable communicating in Romanian and settle into school routines and expectations. Adi and Jen will continue to work at modelling and encouraging a vision for more effective and gospel centred children's ministry, and God will lead them to those He wants them working with. Spending these days with Jen and Adi has filled us with joy and optimism. We love their hearts and vision for ministry, and we are confident that their ministry plans for the coming year will begin to bear fruit. We also love their faithfulness and perseverance in the face of a really tough period. We continue to walk closely with them, and we know how much they value the prayers and encouragement of all those who are partnering with them, which will help see them through this stage. We love the fact that Adi, Jen, Anna and Luca are committed to being here in Romania for the long haul, and we are committed to them. It is our goal help them thrive in life and ministry here, and we are excited to see what God does through them.
