Faithful Provision

As we have travelled, many of you have been curious to the state of our finances, especially given the current situation with inflation all over the world. Even through the toughest times of the pandemic, God has graciously and faithfully provided for all our physical and financial needs through generous and devoted supporters, for which we are immeasurably thankful. Whilst some supporters needed to either reduce or withdraw their support for various reasons over the past four years, God provided for us in other ways. But, like the world over, living costs have increased in Romania also and we have found ourselves in the position to need to increase our financial support levels for this coming term. We are trusting that God will raise up other financial supporters to partner with us to ensure that we can continue to serve in Romania full time. In a recent 'financial check-up', it showed that our current support level is at 90%, still needing to raise another \$702 a month to reach 100%. We would walk with them, pray with them and offer support, advice, encouragement, prayer and help them access the resources and trainings that exist in Romania. We are continuing to trust in God's guidance, making tentative plans, whilst keeping our eyes and hearts open for ways that God may bring this about. As it says in Proverbs 16:9, "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps."



Thank you again to everyone who has welcomed us so warmly during our home assignment in Australia. The time was so short and we wished it could be longer and seen more of you, but we are thankful for what the Lord enabled us to do in the time we had. Thank you for your ongoing encouragement, support, prayer and partnership. It is a blessing to be a part of the body of Christ and see it working together to build God's kingdom here in Australia, Romania and the world over.
